



# GOLF COURSE RULES

**Welcome to Cedar Creek and Aspen Hills Golf Courses!** To preserve the integrity of the game, and the enjoyment of all players, standard golf etiquette will prevail.

## Tee Time Reservations

Advance tee time reservations will be available to all golfers, for members of SVRA, two weeks (14 days) in advance, and for nonmembers, one week (7 days) in advance. All players should note that tee times changes must be made twenty-four (24) hours in advance. Repeated cancellations without prior 24 hour notice will result in requiring a credit card guarantee and charging the golfer making the reservation if cancellations are made after the 24 hour time period.

## Rules of Play

All play and competition will be governed by the rules of the USGA except as modified by the SVRA Golf Committee and SVRA Board.

Check-in - All golfers are required to check in at the pro shop and obtain a receipt of payment prior to beginning play. Member players with season passes may “play to the pro shop” to check in, with advance phone approval from the pro shop and as long as there is no disruption to the rate of play of golfers on the course.

Attire - Traditional golf attire is preferred but not mandatory. All attire is expected to be golf conservative, suitable for all age groups. Golf shoes with rubber cleats are preferred. Metal spikes are not allowed on either course. Other types of shoes may also be permitted by pro shop personnel if they are suitable to be worn on the courses and no harm will be done to the greens.

## General Rules -

1. Pace of Play for 18 holes should be a maximum of 4 ½ hours.
2. Scheduled golf tournaments will have priority over all other play.
3. No more than four (4) players may play together unless approved by the Pro Shop during very slow periods.
4. All golfers are expected to yield to faster playing individuals and groups when there is space to play through. Players looking for a lost ball ( 5 minutes maximum) and players failing to maintain their pace with a group ahead of them, must allow other players coming up to play through.
5. Golfers are requested to fill with sand or replace all divots and repair marks on the courses as they play. Ball marks on the green should be properly lifted and repaired.
6. Trash receptacles are provided on each tee for your convenience.

7. Dogs on the course must be confined to golf carts only.
8. When course maintenance crew is working on a green, no play is allowed until the flag is replaced. When the crew is on the fairways, please allow them an opportunity to observe you and to move to the side to avoid injury.
9. Balls that go into private yards are to be retrieved carefully, on foot, taking care as to not damage personal property. **Never** is a ball to be played from a private yard.

**Course Marshals** – Designated marshals will be on the golf courses as required during hours of play. They may request to review a golfer's receipt, verify a Trail Fee sticker on private carts, call to the attention of players the need to observe these rules and to take such action as they deem necessary, up to and including asking golfers to leave the course.

### **Golf Cart Rules**

Carts, leased and privately owned, must be driven on the courses by licensed drivers. Only two (2) persons per cart are allowed. The exception being that a child may be the third cart occupant, as long as all three occupants of the cart can comfortably occupy the seat. All carts will remain off of private property (most out-of-bounds is private property), thirty (30) feet from the greens and ponds, and not driven on the tees or areas marked as restricted to carts. The exception to the 30 feet greens rule will only apply to those golfers with physical impairments. Those golfers may request a handicap flag from the pro shop which will be displayed on their cart at all times.

### **Rain Checks**

If a golfer is unable to complete their round due to inclement weather, a rain check may be issued based upon the following guidelines.

#### **9 Hole Players**

Played five holes or less  
Started the 6<sup>th</sup> hole of the round

9 Hole Rain Check  
No Rain Check

#### **18 Hole Players**

Played five holes or less  
Played 14 holes or less  
Started the 15<sup>th</sup> hole of the round

18 Hole Rain Check  
9 Hole Rain Check  
No Rain Check

### **Rules Enforcement**

Golf course rules are herein posted and pro shop employees are empowered to enforce the rules. A golfer requested to leave the course will be eligible for a refund of a pro rata portion of the player's fees that represent the unused portion: the rain check guidelines will be used to determine the amount refunded if applicable. Chronic abusers of the Golf Course/Golf Cart Rules may result in the loss of golf/cart privileges.
